Türkiye's and the world's energy agenda will be discussed at the 14th Türkiye Energy Summit

14TH TÜRKİYE ENERGY SUMMIT IN ISTANBUL ON NOVEMBER 25-26

The 14th Türkiye Energy Summit, which has become traditional as the "Largest Family Gathering" of the Turkish energy industry, will be held on November 25-26, 2024 at the Hilton Istanbul Bomonti Hotel Conference Center. Organized by Enerji Fuarcılık with the main theme of "Energy of the Future, Economics of Energy", the Summit will bring together public and private sector representatives. As the first and only organization that brings together electricity, natural gas, fuel oil, LPG and sustainable energy markets, the Türkiye Energy Summit will also address issues such as e-mobility and energy storage, which are prominent today.

Organized for the 14th time this year, the Türkiye Energy Summit will keep its finger on the pulse of the energy sector as it does every year. The effects of the energy transformation, which has become the most important topic of the world energy agenda, on Türkiye and global energy markets, future trends, expectations and requirements of the Turkish energy sector participants in this process, changes created by new technologies such as digitalization, storage and e-mobility in the sector, economic and financial aspects of developments in the energy industry, and issues affecting the energy agenda in countries and regions closely related to Türkiye, especially in the Eastern Mediterranean and the Middle East, will be discussed in all their dimensions on November 25-26.

The Türkiye Energy Summit, which brings together more than 1,500 national and international participants with senior figures from public institutions and organizations of Türkiye and the countries in the region, will also open the door to new cooperation opportunities. In addition to contributing to the future forecasts of participants and decision-makers, the Türkiye Energy



Summit will also enable the development of strategic solutions in line with the developments and needs in the energy sector.

In its 14th year, with the main theme of "*Energy of the Future, Economics of Energy*", the Summit will continue to play the role of a driving force with its support for the progress of the sector by enabling the problems and solutions of the energy sector to be discussed by the most authorized experts.
